

# Getting Started- Training Roadmap

## Program Overview

### Prerequisites:

It should be understood that the Bio Cranial System™ Certification program is a postgraduate one & is open only to health practitioners who meet the following criteria:

- The practitioner is already qualified or licensed in his/her existing jurisdiction.
- The practitioner has undertaken a rigorous training in the basic sciences such as anatomy, physiology, biology, and pathology.
- In general, the practitioner is considered to be a primary care practitioner in his, or her, field – MD, DO, DC, OMD, DDS etc, or the international equivalent.

### Components of Level I Completion:

The training program is structured as follows:

**Home Study Course** which consists of the following materials which are mailed immediately after sign up:

- The textbook, “*An Introduction to Bio Cranial Therapy*”, by Robert Boyd, DO
- The “*Home Study Manual*”, by Robert Boyd, DO
- Guide notes on the study material
- “Headway to Health” by Robert Boyd, DO

The estimated study time is 20 – 30 hours. The material contained in the Home Study Course is, for the most part, refreshingly ground breaking, even for those who have been exposed to other cranial based studies. ***Completion of the Home Study Course is required before attending the "Hands-On-Training". Be sure that sufficient time is allowed for thorough home study.***

**The "Hands-On-Training"** is the practical component devoted primarily to hands on instruction. It is an intense, but relaxed three days of instruction. The number of attendees per class is strictly limited and the ratio of instructors to attendees is geared so that maximum supervision and personal instruction is available. Bio Cranial System instructors are highly trained holding Diplomate in The Biocranial System status (*The "Hands On Training" may be repeated by request at a reduced rate.*)

## Bio Cranial System™ Certification Levels

### **“Level I Completion”**

- Home Study Course
- Hands-On-Training
- Written exam with passing grade

*Attendees will complete a written test during the Hands-On-Training. The questions are based on the material contained in the Home Study Course. Questions will have choices from multi part answers or true and false. In the event of a student failing to reach the requisite pass mark, there will be an opportunity to complete a re-take, from a different test paper.*

- Demonstration of Proficiency

Once verification of training is complete the new practitioners will be posted on the web as “Level I Completed”.

### **“Level II Certification”**

- 6 months experience with the Bio Cranial System™
- 2 Continuing Professional Development Seminars (CPDs\*)
- Demonstration of Proficiency
- *(If needed, additional CPDs\*)*

When the work for Level II Certification is completed, practitioners are to submit in writing the dates of classes attended.

Once verification of training is complete, it will be posted on the web as “Level II Certified”.

### **"Level III Certification"**

- 2 years experience with the Bio Cranial System™
- 4 CPDs and Demonstration of Proficiency at each CPD\*
- When the work for Level III Certification is completed, practitioners are to submit in writing the dates of classes attended.

Once verification of training is complete, it will be posted on the web as “Level III Certified”.

### **“Diplomate Bio Cranial System™” – “DBCS”**

- 5 years experience
- 6 CPDs and Demonstration of Proficiency at each CPD\*
- Submit 20 case studies

- A Vivo (Short interview as part of an overall assessment of a person's knowledge base)
- Has demonstrated reputable, trustworthy character professionally and otherwise
- Project of a special nature with some significant contribution to BCS

*Project ideas can be submitted for approval, i.e. writing a book or noteworthy article, clinical research project, mission work.*

When the work for Diplomate status is completed, practitioners are to submit in writing their request along with the matriculation fee and the completed Diplomate "Practitioner Information Card".

### **\*Continuing Professional Development (CPD)**

Continuing Professional Development workshops are designed to provide a forum for Members who wish to review any area of their work relative to the Bio Cranial System™ (BCS). This may relate, for example, to any aspect of the teachings, philosophical and/ or practical, or to areas such as patient education or office protocol. The session is intended to be flexible, and will be tailored to the needs and wishes of participants while, at the same time, having a degree of structured teaching.
